New members wanting to join will need to fill in a membership form, available from our porch and bring proof of ID. A donation of £2.50 would be welcome.

To ensure that people continue to feel safe visiting The Tottington Centre, the following Covid protocols will remain in place:

- We would encourage our members to wear a face covering when moving around The Tottington Centre (unless exempt)
- Maintain a safe distance between yourself and others
- Scan the Track and Trace QR Code when entering the building or use the paper sign in sheet
- The rule of 6 or two households will no longer apply but be assured, we will monitor the flow of people to ensure there is no overcrowding of the building
- The Perspex shield at the counter will remain to offer some protection for you and our volunteers
- We do not need books in guarantine for 72 hours
- We will keep the hand sanitisers and we would still ask computer users to sanitise computers before and after use
- We will keep ventilating the rooms and the front door will be kept open and windows too
- If you are using our rooms, you will need to sign in as you did before the pandemic. Volunteers will guide you to the signing in book.
